THE JUNIOR LEAGUE DIFFERENCE

Since 1978, the Junior League of Reno's projects have varied tremendously and have made a crucial impact within the Northern Nevada community. The Junior League of Reno is different in that our projects and partnerships – while always benefitting women and children – change to meet our community's most pressing needs. Some of our projects include:



Reno's first Universally Accessible Playground, Inspiration Station, for children and adults of all abilities at Dick Taylor Park. The goal of building this park was achieved through fundraising and corporate sponsorships.

Girls on the Run, a program designed to instill selfconfidence and empower young girls throughout the Reno area. In 2019-2020, The Junior League of Reno was able to sponsor six Title 1 schools in the program, provide coaches and volunteers for their celebratory 5k.

Volunteers of America Playground for the homeless families in temporary residence and annual baby showers with food and gifts for new and expecting homeless mothers.

Renown Pediatric Clinic renovation for low-income families including refreshed exam rooms and new equipment to help and heal thousands of local youth.

Feed The Need single-day donation drive, successfully raising \$52,000 for the Washoe County school lunch program, serving lunches to homeschooling youth during the COVID-19 outbreak.

With our current focus on the increasing presence of childhood food insecurity, the Junior League of Reno provides volunteers and assists on the farm at **Urban Roots**, assists and serves meals at **St**. **Vincent's Catholic Charities**, collects and distributes food and donations for **Karma Box**, provides and serves meals at **Eddy House** - a shelter for homeless youth, collects food and assists the **Northern Nevada Food Bank** and donates teddy bears to the pediatric wing at Renown.

In addition to our partnerships and ongoing volunteer efforts, the Junior League of Reno awards annual Community Enrichment Grants and additional funding. In 2020-2021, JL RENO awarded nine community organizations over \$28,000, creating a significant impact on our community. As Reno grows, so too does its needs, and Junior League of Reno's PRAD [Project Research and Development Committee] is continuously investigating the latest data trends and looking for ways to make the biggest difference. We also launched a PAAC [Public Awareness and Advocacy Committee] in conjunction with The Junior League of Las Vegas to support the wellbeing and security of women and children of Nevada during legislative sessions.
